

Skopje



- Area: 571,5 km²

- Sights/ nice places: Stone Bridge (width: 6m; length: 214m), Millenium Cross, Skopje Zoo, Feudal Tower, Vodno (1066m), Treska (river), Memorial House of Mother Teresa



- Population: 536 271 (2012)

- It was known in the Roman period under the name Scupi

- Founded: 1964
- The school is named after Kreste Misirkov, who was a philologist and historian.
- Students: 853

- In Northern Europe
- Capital: Tallinn
- Population: 1.316 million (2016)
- Official language: Estonian
- President: Kersti Kaljulaid
- Area: 45,336km²
- 50% of Estonia is covered by forest land
- The creators of Skype were mostly Estonian

Tartu



- Population: 97,332 (Estonians-80.1%; Russians-14.6%; other-5.3%)
Area: 38.8 km² (land-37.9 km²; water-1.3 km²)
- Second biggest city in Estonia
- Mayor: Urmas Klaas
- Elevation: 57.2m
- Tartu is considered as the intellectual centre of Estonia
- birthplace of Estonian Song Festivals
- University of Tartu



Tallinn



- Area: 159.2 km²
- Population: 413,782 (2015)
- Elevation: 9 m
- Known for Old-Tallinn (one of the best preserved medieval cities in Europe)
- Received city rights in 1248
- Tallinn is the political, financial, cultural and educational center of Estonia
- European Capital of Culture for 2011 (+Turku in Finland)



Tartu Veeriku School

- Address: Veeriku 41, 50407 Tartu, Estonia
- The school was opened in 1987.
- The school was originally named the 17th Basic School in Tartu.
- Up until 1992, the school had both Russian and Estonian, 15 Estonian and 4 Russian classes.
- Students: about 700 (2017)
